Report on Seminar

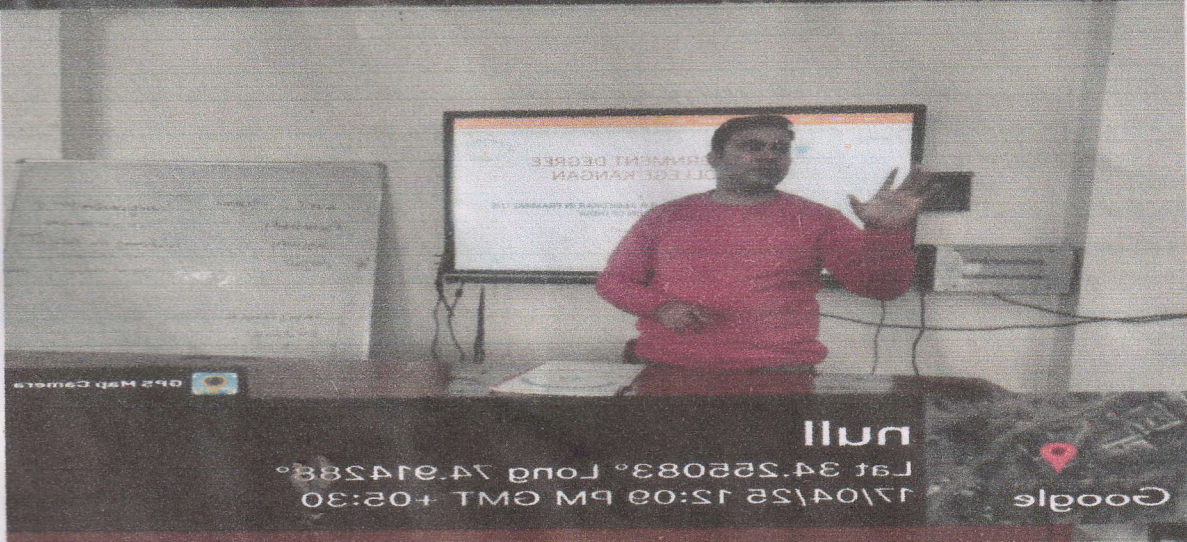
