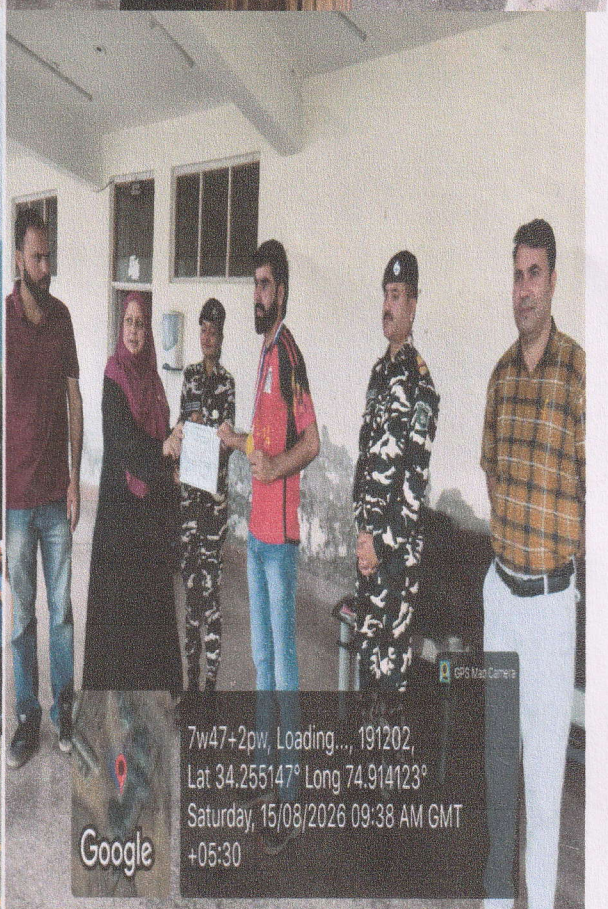
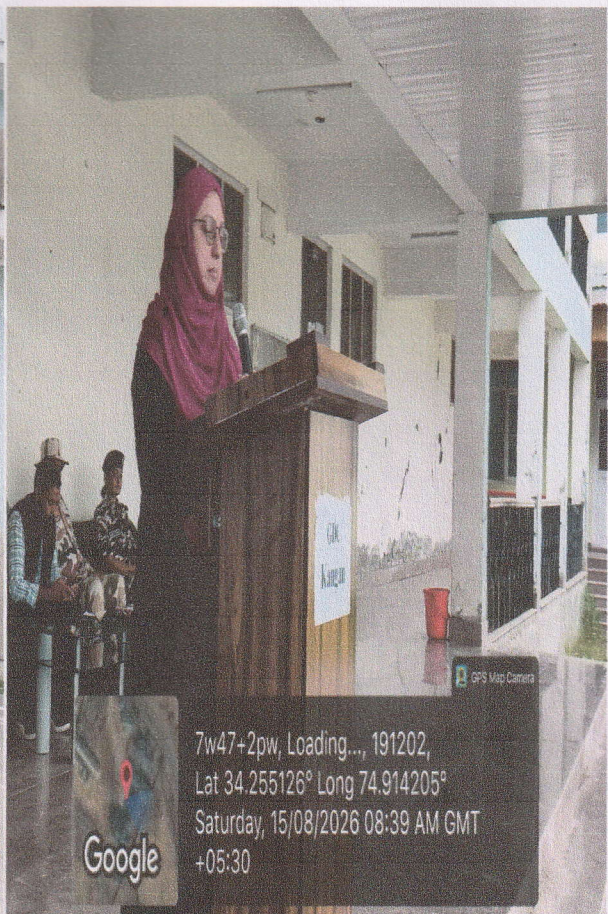
Felicitation Ceremony
