

Report on Journey of Seventy Five Years of Indian Constitution

As part of the Celebration of 75 Years of Adoption of Constitution of India under the tagline HamaraSamvidhanHamaraSwabhimanand 150th Birth Anniversary of SardarVallabhai Patel, Department of Political Science Government Degree College Kangan organised a Lecture on "Journey of 75 Years of Indian Constitution" on 10-06-2025.
