## Report on Awareness Program Regarding New Criminal Laws



She praised the structural shift towards speedy and transparent justice delivery.

Prof Zahoor Ahmad Dar Head Department of Political Science through his Power point Presentation explained the key features and objectives of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, which replaces the IPC. He elaborated on the new provisions related to mob lynching, terrorism, and gender-based crimes. He also appreciated the focus on time-bound investigations and trials. He highlighted the inclusion of digital evidence, reversal of burden of proof in certain cases, and changes in admissibility rules.

The program concluded with Q&A session followed the expert talks where students and faculty members posed thoughtful questions. The experts addressed the queries with real-life examples, making the discussion highly interactive and educational. Prof. Waseem Yaseen Head of the Department of Environmental Science delivered a vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the speakers and participants for making the event agreat success.
