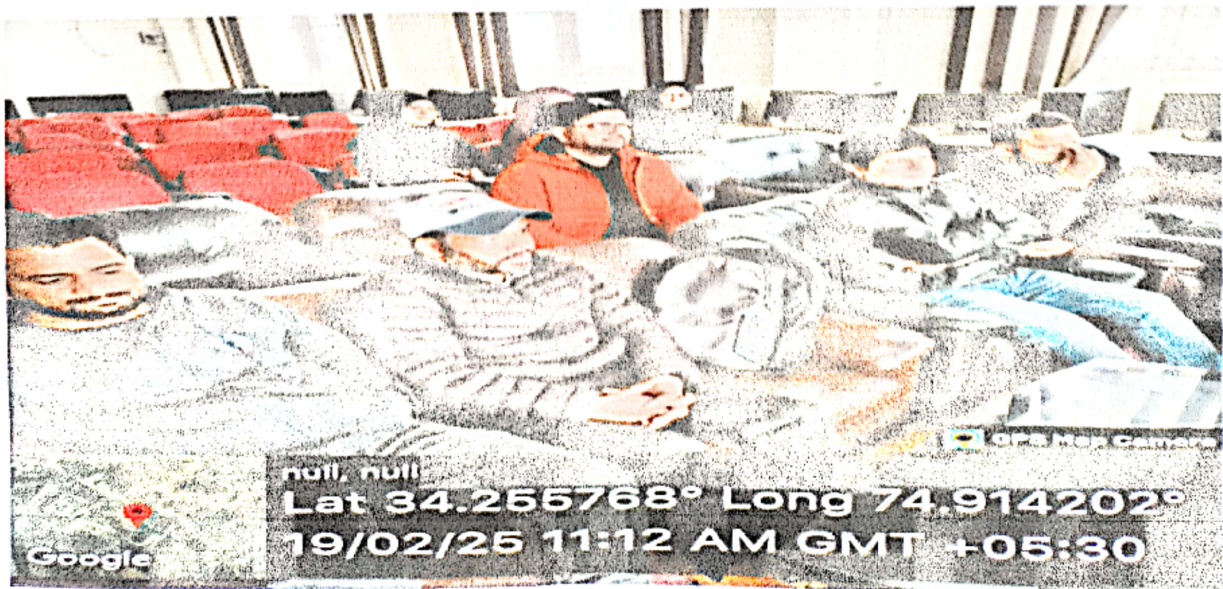

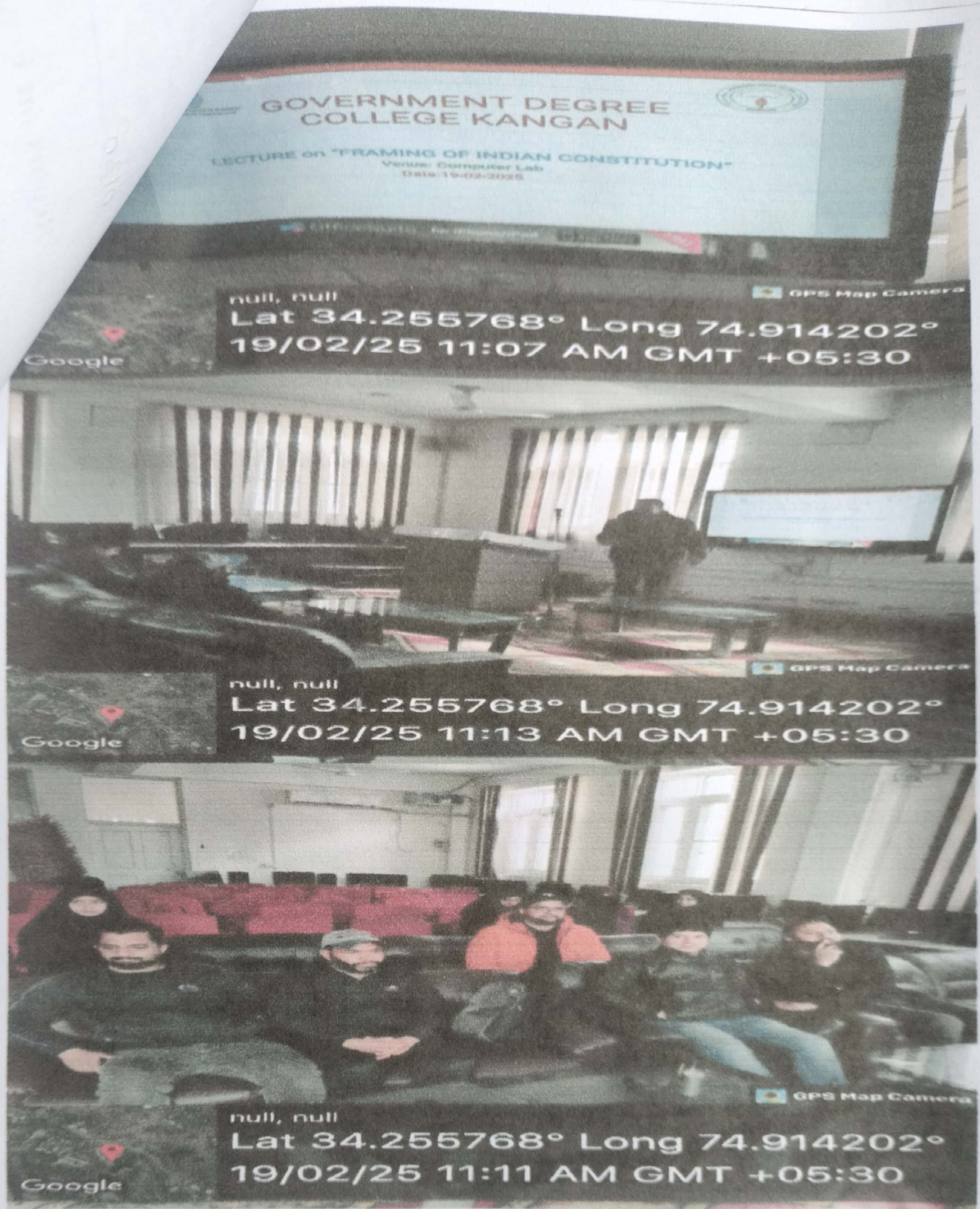

Report on Framing of Indian constitution

As part of Celebration of 75 Years of Adoption of Constitution of India and 150th Birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhai Patel, Department of Political Science Government Degree College Kangan organised a Lecture on **"Framing of Indian Constitution"** on 19-02-2025. The main purpose of the lecture was to explore the historical background of the Constitution, its key features, structure of governance and its relevance in modern India. The lecture was delivered by Prof. Zahoor Ahmad Dar Head Department of Political Science. The lecture provided a comprehensive overview of the framing of the Indian Constitution, highlighting key aspects of the process and its significance. The speaker began by setting the historical context, emphasizing the important period preceding the Constitution's creation, marked by both the joy of independence and the trauma of partition. The speaker gave an overview of the Constitution and said that it is a remarkable document that embodies the principles of justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity. It consists of 22 parts, 448 articles, and 12 schedules. The Constitution establishes India as a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic republic, ensuring social, economic, and political justice for all citizens.

The speaker gave detailed information about the formation and workings of the Constituent Assembly, emphasizing its diverse representation and the democratic nature of its deliberations. The speaker also highlighted the contributions of key figures like Dr B.R. Ambedkar, the chairman of the Drafting Committee, and the extensive debates and discussions that shaped the document. Key features of the Constitution, such as its preamble, fundamental rights, directive principles of state policy, and the parliamentary system of government, were discussed. The lecture concluded by vote of Thanks presented by Prof. Waseem Yaeen Head Department of Environment Science. He emphasised that Constitution is a living document that continues to guide India's democratic journey. He encouraged the audience to engage with the Constitution and uphold its values.
